

GENERAL CARE & MAINTENANCE

- For daily care, wipe with a damp soft cloth in the direction of the wood grain and dry immediately.
- For thorough cleaning, we recommend using a mixture of mild soap and warm water along with a soft clean cloth for both the exterior and interior of your cabinets. Wipe cabinets clean of soap mixture with another soft clean cloth and dry immediately.
- To clean glass doors, spray glass cleaner onto a soft cloth and wipe. Do not spray glass cleaner directly onto the glass.
- Avoid leaving moisture on your cabinet surface for an extended period of time. It can absorb into the core of the wood and cause swelling of the material.
- Wipe spills and splatters immediately as they can permanently stain the exterior of your cabinets over time.
- Never use strong soap, abrasives, or scouring pad to clean. These can damage the cabinets as well as discoloration of the finished surfaces.
- Waxing and polishing are not recommended. The chemical compounds in wax and polish may change the exterior finish of your cabinets over time and are very difficult to remove.
- Keep steam away from exterior and underside of cabinets. Kettle, coffee maker, etc. should be placed in open area when in use. Excessive heat and moisture from the use of these appliances can result in damage to the finished surface, loosening of adhesive on edge bandings around the cabinet, and swelling of material.
- Continuous exposure to sunlight can fade the exterior color of the cabinets creating uneven color tones. Protect your cabinets from direct sunlight by using draperies or blinds.
- Minor scratches can be repaired with our touch-up markers. They are available for purchase and come in most of the stain colors we offer. Touch-up markers are not available for painted finishes. For custom colors, please request in advance.
